use of strongly contrasting ideas, words, or images
a brief, cleverly worded statement that makes a wise observation about life
a speaker or writer's choice of words
how a speaker or writer presents themselves to their audience
the logic, reasoning, evidence, and explanations which the speaker uses to persuade the audience
repeating a grammatical structure for emphasis
the ways in which a speaker appeals to the audience's emotions
the intensifying or building toward a climax, usually accompanied by the speaker getting louder and more passionate
a literary device that repeats the same words or phrases a few times to make an idea clearer
the arrangement of words and phrases to create well- formed sentences in a language.
